

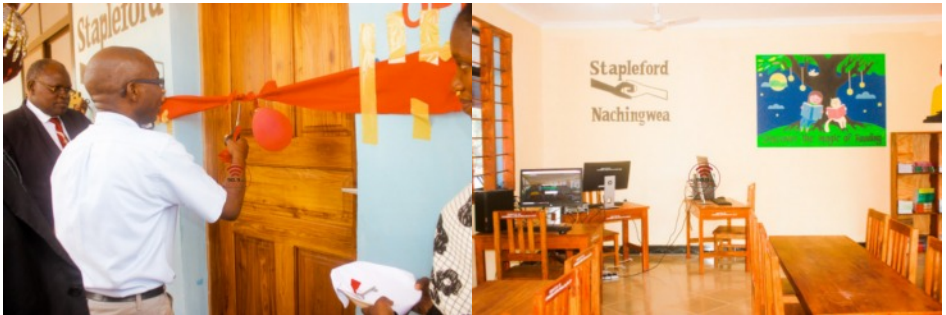
## New library opening
