

Tanzania census

CHAIR of the Nachingwea, Link Kevin Bushiri, has been acting as one of the 1,000 census clerks in the Nachingwea district during the national census carried out at the end of August. At the end of July Kevin and the other clerks received three weeks training from the National Bureau of Statistics in the asking of questions and the collection and transmission of data using tablets - this is the first census to be conducted using electronic devices. Tanzania conducts a census after every ten years.
